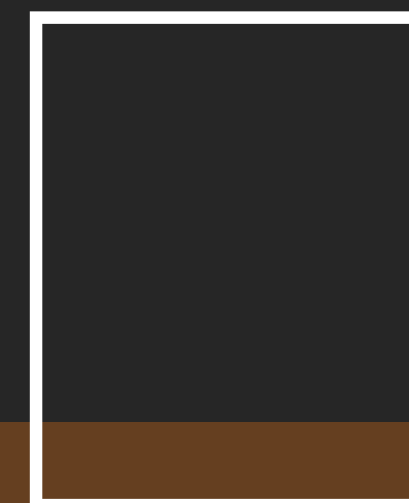
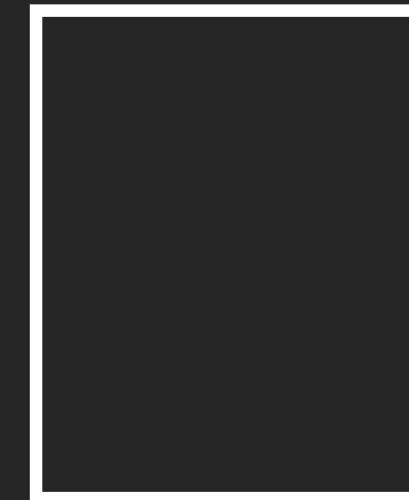


STUDENT VOICE

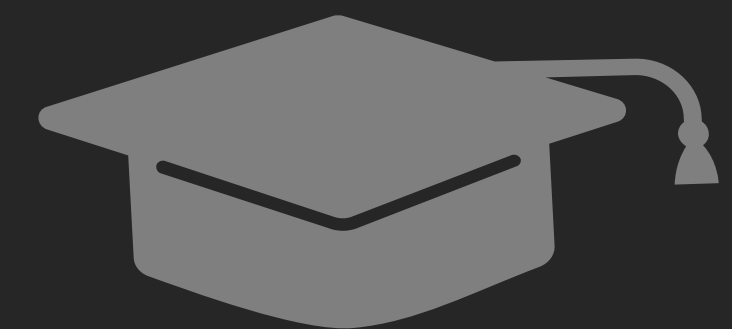

YOUR DUTIES + RESPONSIBILITIES

How to be a GREAT Class Rep --

- Engage with classmates, listen out for complaints in class + gather student opinions
- Develop & Implement a solution - talk to lecturer / course-coordinator
- Talk to Education VP &/ the Advocate
- Feedback to students
- Email Monthly feedback report to Education VP &/ the Advocate
- Participate in meetings with course-coordinator/lecturer & student korero



GETTING & GIVING FEEDBACK

- Use Facebook - wisely :)
- Casually strike up a casual conversation with people in class about how they're doing / Survey
- Stand up in class & request a formal feedback / via lecturer
- Email it to Education VP or refer student to the Advocate



YOU CAN ASK PEOPLE IN YOUR CLASS:

WHAT IS GOING WELL/ ARE THEY HAPPY WITH?

Is the amount of assigned readings doable for you?

Are the assessments spaced out throughout the semester?

Is your lecturer coming to class on time?

Are you learning everything you'd have wanted to in this class?

Do the lecturers clarify your questions and queries in time?

Are you getting enough guidance/support from the lecturer?

WHAT IS NOT GOING WELL? / COMPLAINTS

Is the course objective clear?

How do you feel about the class structure/course structure?

Is the teacher's teaching style okay for you?

Are they treating everyone equally and appreciate everyone's opinion and answer all your questions?

Do you feel like there is enough support for you from the lecturer?

You've GOT to stay in the loop with both students and teachers

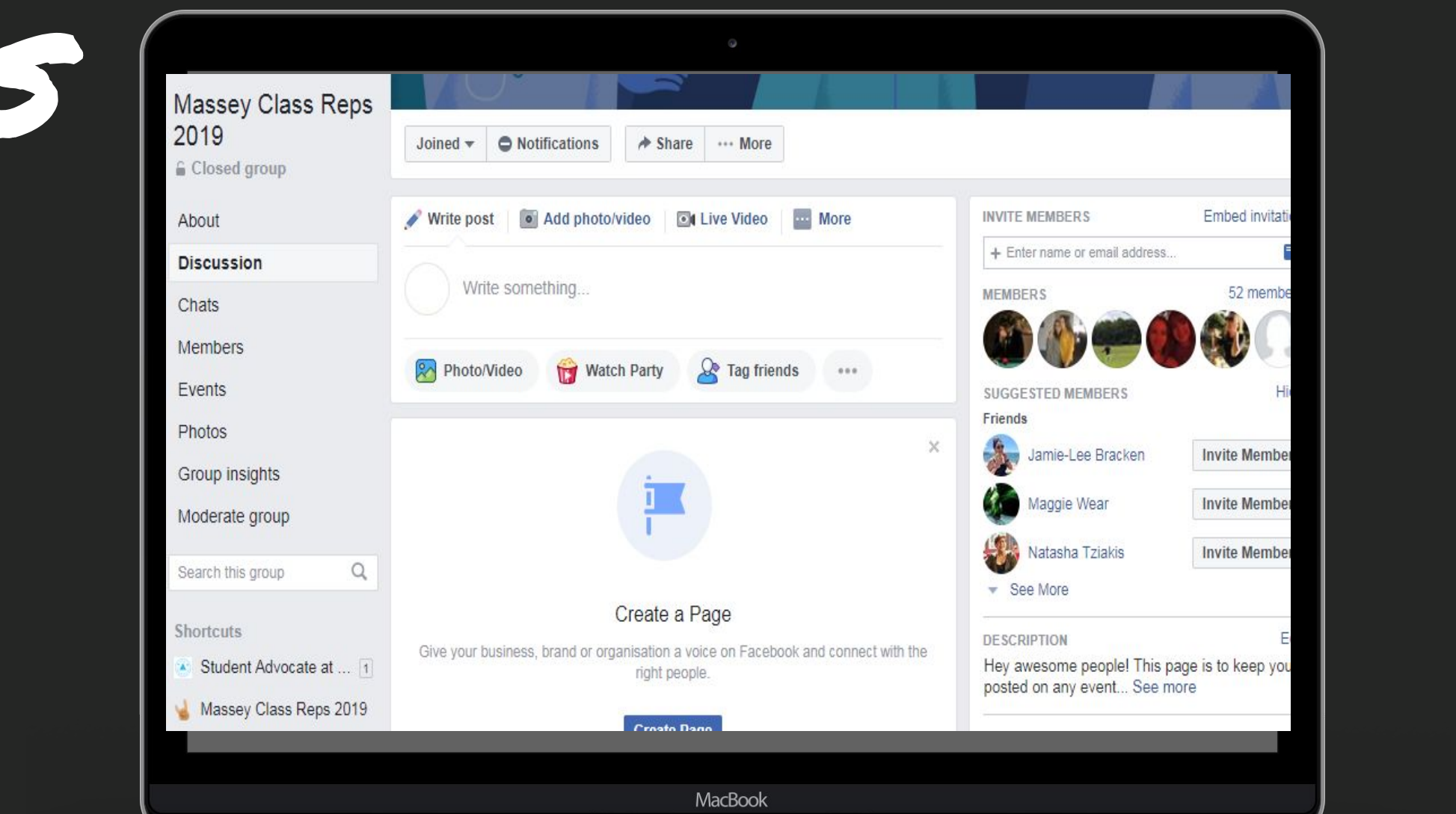
Email the lecturer as soon as a student emailed you about a problem
